### Parliamentary Candidate joins Labour.

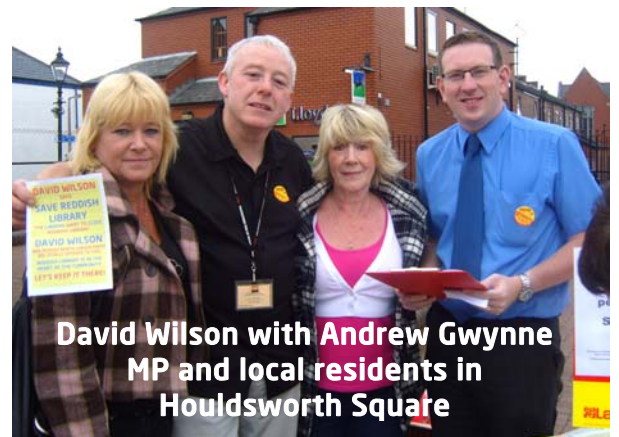
