REDDISH BATHS THE TRUTH!

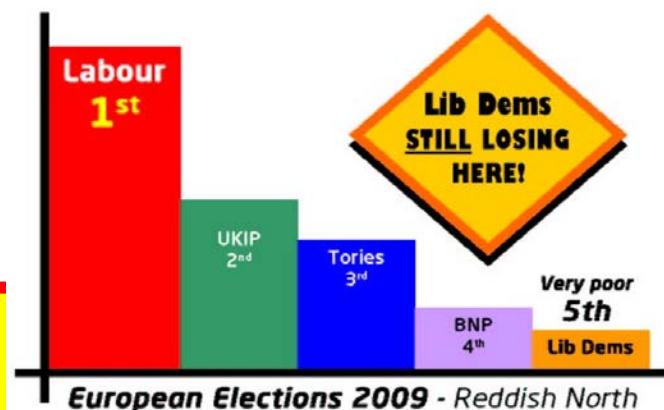
